

Sutton, Bignor, Barlavington, Burton and Coates 100 Club

Rules

1. The scheme is to be known as the **SBBBC 100 Club**.
2. The Club will commence on the 5th September 2005 with the first draw on 30th September.
3. Subscriptions will be £2 per month per number (numbers will normally be sold in blocks of 5).
4. Each number will have an equal chance of winning a prize.
5. Subscribers must be at least 16 years of age.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to limit subscriptions to a maximum of 5 numbers per subscriber.
7. Subscriptions will be paid by bank standing order.
8. Credit will not be allowed to subscribers.
9. The total money received each month will be shared 50% in prizes and 50% divided between the 5 churches.
10. Prizes: First Prize 25%, Second Prize 15% and two Third Prizes of 5% each.
11. The draw will take place in public on the last Friday of every month.

We're starting a 100 Club to help pay the running costs of our churches.

This is how it'll work:

- Draw on the last Friday of each month at the White Horse.
- Prize money 50% of proceeds.

First Prize	£250
Second Prize	£150
Third Prize	£50
Fourth Prize	£50

**Prize values assume 100 people buy 5 numbers each.*

- 50% of proceeds shared by the 5 churches.
- Membership open to all.
- Numbers cost £2 each, normally sold in blocks of 5 just like raffle tickets.

A fun way to help the village church.

Why the Church is starting a 100 Club

- The 5 churches urgently need more income to help pay their running costs.
- The 100 Club will bring our monthly income much nearer to covering monthly running costs.
- This means enough money to keep the churches open.

More about the 100 Club

- A 100 Club works just like a raffle. Each number has an equal chance of winning a prize.
- The big difference is that the odds are far better than a raffle or Lotto.
- Value of prizes will increase if more than 100 blocks of 5 tickets are sold each month & fall if less are sold.
- Payment by bank standing order cuts administration costs, leaving more for prizes and the churches.
- The law says that £2 is the maximum price for a number. We want you to buy a block of 5.
- Winning numbers (not names) will be published in Village News.
- The 100 Club will be supervised by a committee, one person from each church (Sutton, Norman Young; Bignor, David Hunter; Barlavington, Will Lawes; Burton, Richard Archer; and Coates, Vivian Miles) & run by an independent person (Gordon Owen).
